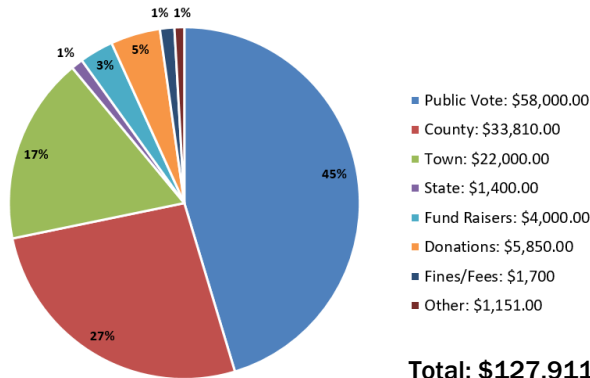

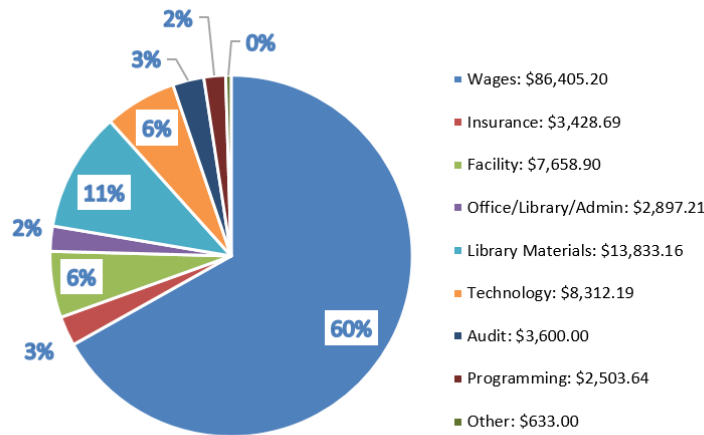
For The Year 2018
