## How to Register:

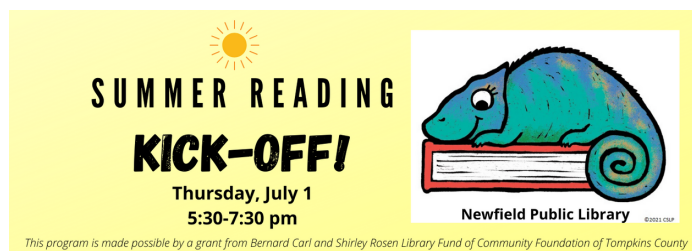
- Sign up [here](#). Please register each participant individually.
