Grants and Donations

United Way SRP grant awarded \$1550

Submitted FOL grant app for \$500 to improve diversity of holiday picture book collection.

This seems to be a logical beginning step toward having more diversity at the library.

Larry Miller has made progress with the ramp and railings at the History and Events Center. This should be completed soon. The Historical Society is requesting changes in the language regarding which members of the historical society may have keys. They would like to remove the town historian and add NHS Chief Archivist. The regulations require that a town historian not be the head leadership in a historical society. This change would be more aligned with the regulations. The discussion was this change makes sense and would have little to no impact and it is aligned with the requirements in the lease to limit the number of keys available. We do not have a quorum so we cannot vote on this, but we will let the NHS know that we do not foresee an issue and we will be voting on this at our next meeting.

As far as funding for the NHS, Sue provided a list of the expenses and the income for the history center. We need to vote on if we continue with the lease. The NHS is asking the town to increase their contribution to \$10,000 and they should ask that this is an annual contribution

The NHS has a draft of a letter to The Town of Newfield. They gave a paper copy to Sue. They are looking for feedback. Sue gave them some suggestions. A PDF of the letter was emailed to members of the board during the meeting.
